

3 Homeschool Declarations

1. God gives me wisdom or direction for our homeschool every time I ask him. I don't question whether or not He will speak to me. Every time I need wisdom and direction for our homeschool, He gives it to me generously. I do not doubt what He speaks but embrace it with confidence. (James 1:5-6)
2. Our homeschool walks in freedom, not bondage. We are not slaves to curriculum, workbooks, math lessons, enrichment activities, or other commitments on our calendar. We know when to take a break and when to restart. We hear the voice of the Lord, and He is faithful to guide us. 3. In our homeschool, we are joined together in perfect unity—with one heart, one passion, and united in one love. We are free from pride-filled opinions that would harm our unity. We don't allow self-promotion to hide in our hearts. We are humble, putting others first and viewing them as more important than ourselves. We reject every form of selfishness in our homeschool. We care more about what matters to others than what's important to us. Our example is Jesus Christ, and his mindset is our motivation. (Philippians 2:2-5)
